Defeating a personal injury claim for minor injuries

A claim for special damages totalling over £800,000, excluding general damages and interest, had been submitted. There was a suspicion that the claimant was exaggerating her injuries to increase the damages.

Securing a periodical payment order for a catastrophic injury claim


A road traffic accident resulted in a catastrophic injury, leaving the claimant requiring round the clock care, which was pleaded at up to £11 million. The defendant was seeking a periodical payment order (PPO) to enable damages to be paid as annual payments throughout the lifetime of the claimant, rather than as a lump sum.
