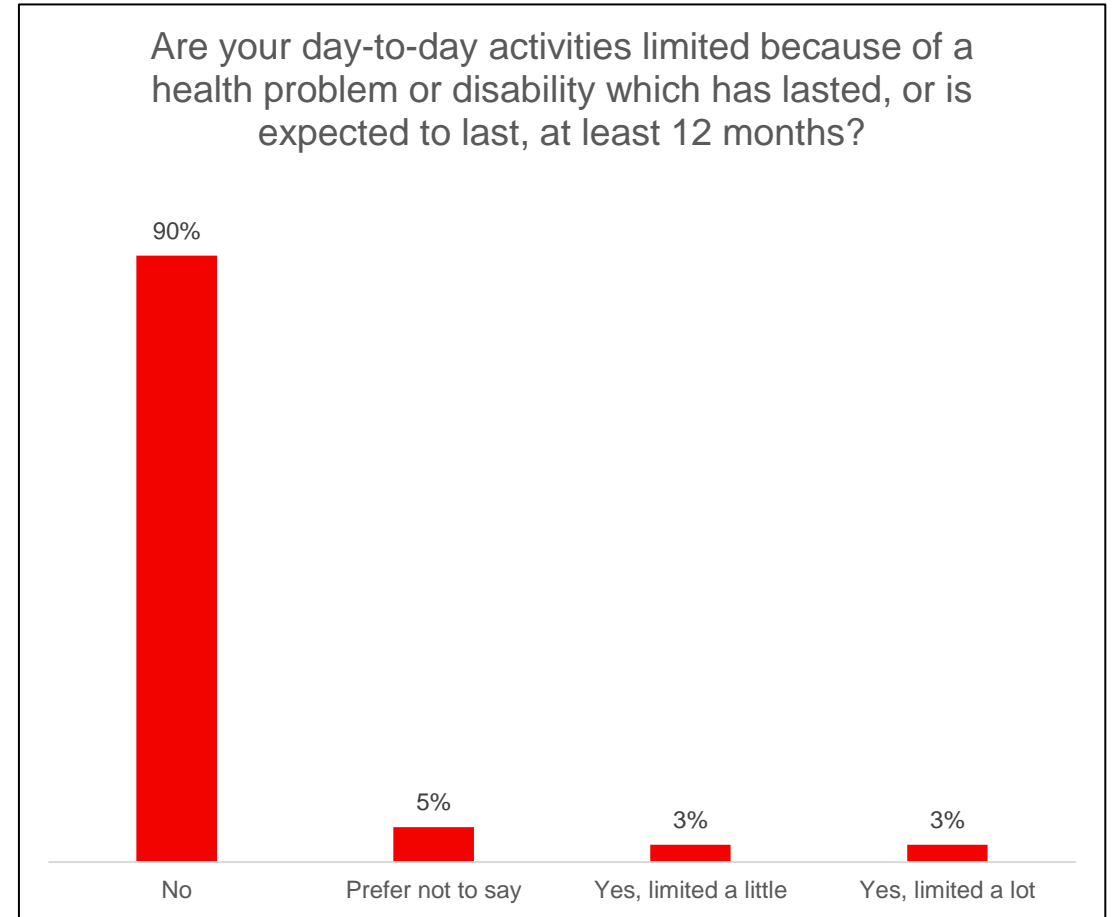
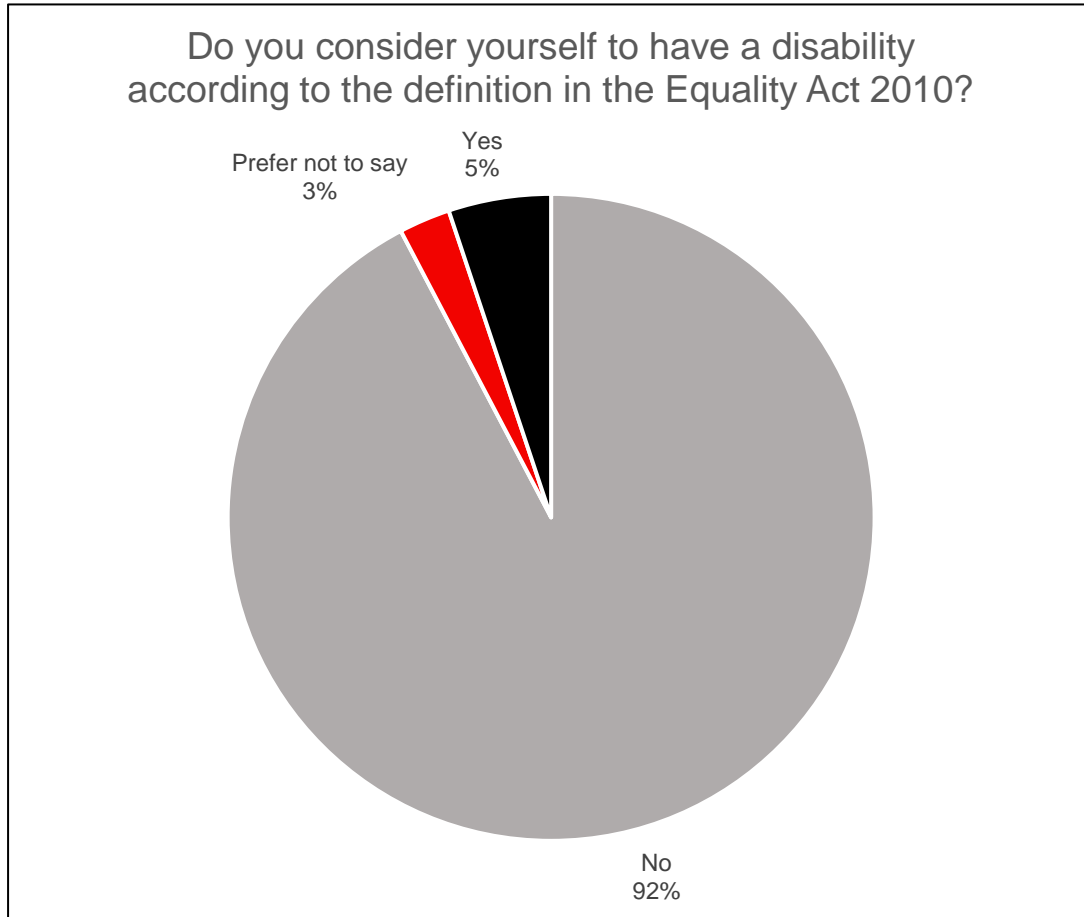
Respondent demographics



Gender and sexual orientation

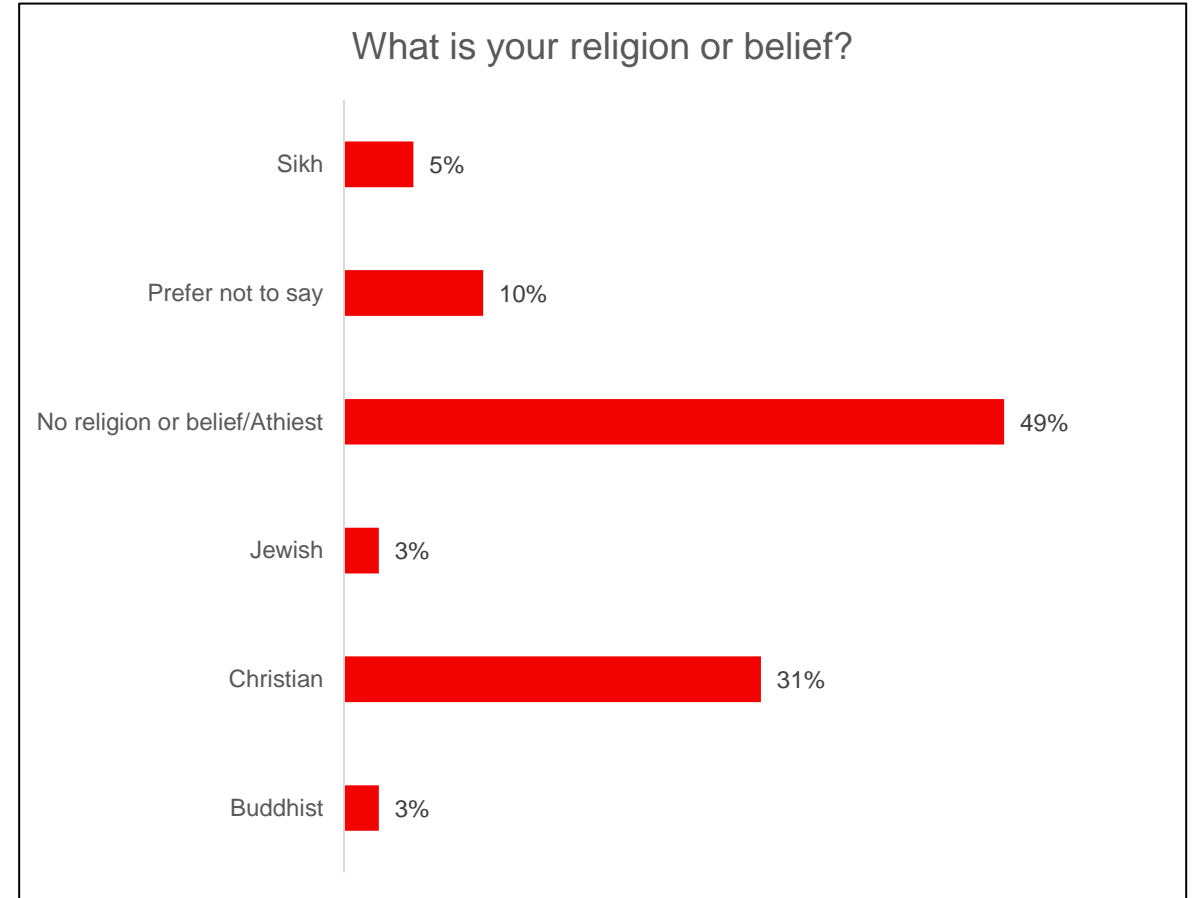

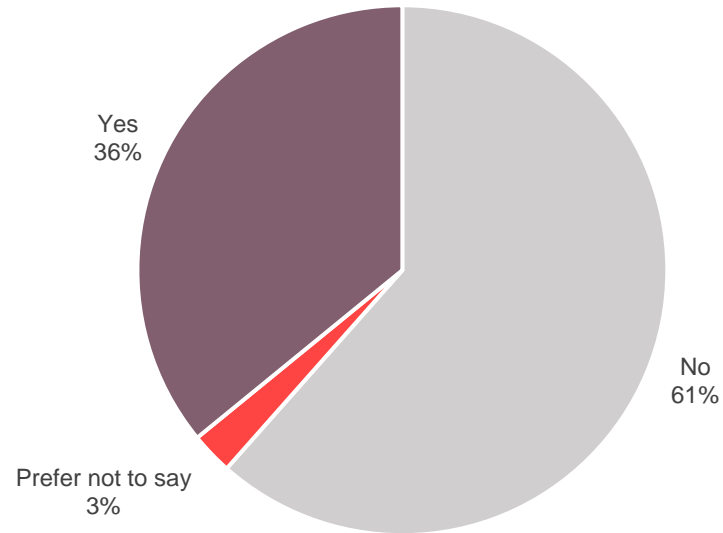

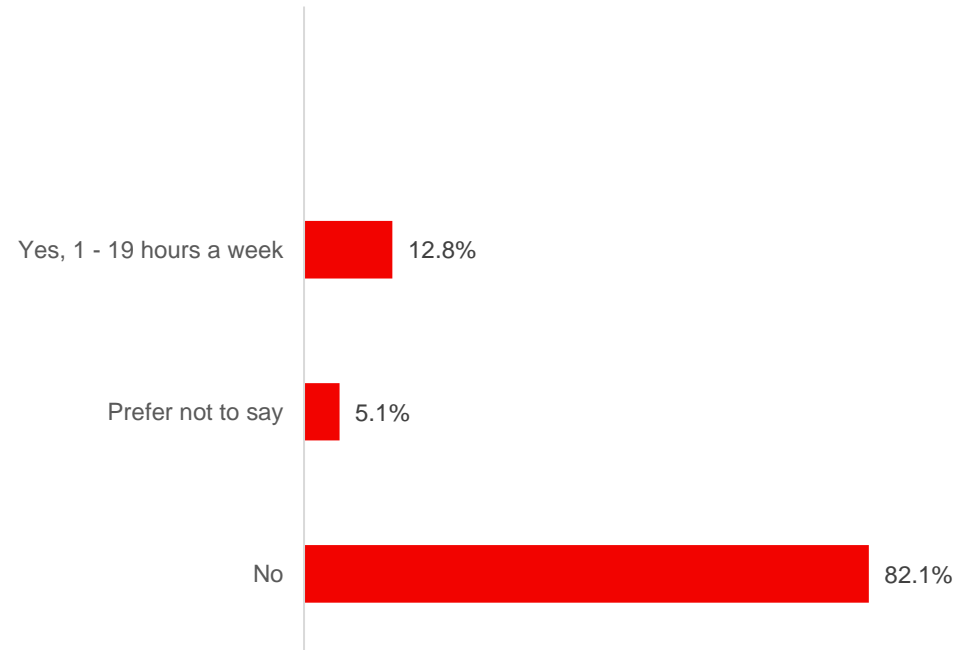
