Roughly 75% of qualified solicitors work at law firms About 25% of qualified solicitors work in-house

80% of qualified barristers work in a chambers, the other 20% work in-house

### What on Earth is Magic or Silver Circle...

**"Magic Circle"** is an informal term describing the five most prestigious London headquartered multi-national law firms - these generally (but not always) outperform the rest of London's law firms in terms of turnover (£ per year).

The current Magic Circle firms are:



"Silver Circle" is an informal term for perceived 'elite' corporate law firms and are the main competitors for the Magic Circle. They post lower overall turnover figures than Magic Circle firms, but are more profitable than Magic Circle firms. The current Silver Circle firms are:

Corporate, Commercial (IP, Tech, Brands, Health etc.), Education, Private client & charities, Banking, Corporate tax, Government & Infrastructure.

Clinical negligence, Inquests & Advisory

Commercial property, Development & Housing, Property Litigation, Retail & Leisure.

Government Regulatory Advocacy (GRA), Social care & complex claims, Insurance (motor claims etc.), Public Law, Planning & Environmental

Construction, Employment, Commercial disputes resolution, Financial & Professional Risk (FPR), Insolvency & Disputes (London), Contentious Probate



In-house counsel are hired by an organisation's legal department to handle a range of issues affecting the company: employment, policy, tax and regulatory matters etc. They play a managerial role, overseeing work that's been outsourced to solicitors at private practice firms
