Browne Jacobson's Irish corporate team has advised Dutch-based mobility business, Pon, on its investment in Donegal-based micromobility company, Ride Today.

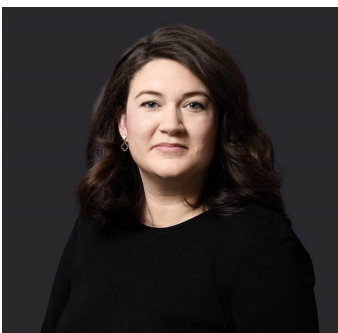
