Shared Insights: CQC enforcement and prosecution in the health and care sector

This session focused on insights from our extensive experience of supporting health and care providers with CQC registration issues, enforcement action and prosecution.

Eleanor shared the key risk indicators identified through her practice that would suggest a greater likelihood the CQC would decide to prosecute an offence. Kathryn shared her insights from her real world experience of CQC action from an in house perspective and practical strategies for managing investigations, enforcement and prosecution by the CQC.
