I hope you find this edition of The Word engaging and thought-provoking.

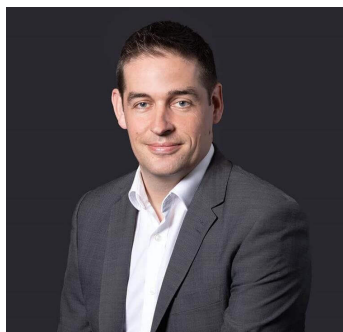
