We hope you find this edition informative and insightful.

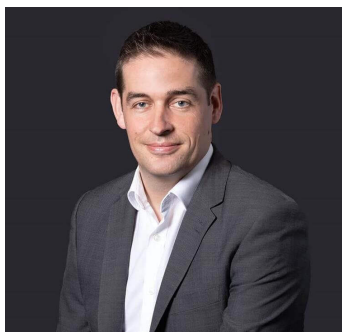
