# What are the barriers for good sports club governance?

## 1. Limited resources

Clubs, particularly at the grass roots, often face financial constraints making it challenging to allocate resources to governance practices.

## 2. Volunteer capacity

Reliance on volunteers may lead to limited time and expertise available for governance tasks. There can often be a resistance to get involved and take on more administrative burden that takes the volunteer away from the sport itself.

## 3. Awareness and training

Volunteers may lack awareness and training on governance standards, hindering effective implementation.
