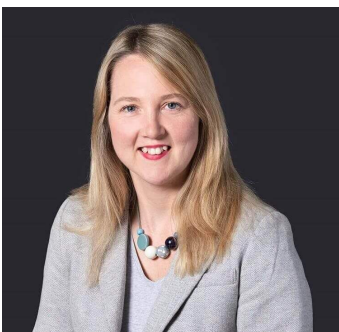
During the session, we explore some real world examples to unpick what can go wrong and how you can effectively challenge parents' unreasonable behaviour, effectively and compliantly.
