

Manchester law firm raises thousands for local charities with Christmas campaign

The campaign concluded yesterday on 17th December with a cheque presentation to bereavement charity CRUSE, and the Browne Jacobson Manchester team presented donations to Dogs4Rescue and Ollie's Army in the days prior.
