

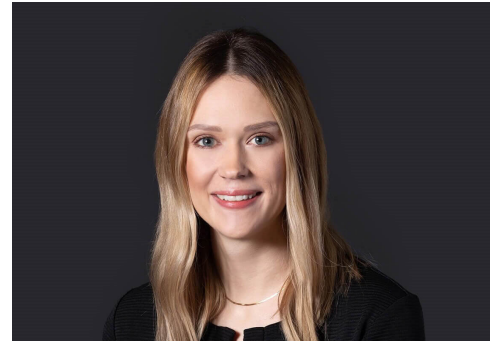
Sarah Stork
